

Record an Eagle Scout Project

You will need to have the Eagle Scout project workbook handy.

Input the data requested:

- The applicant's full name
- The project completion date
- Number of Scouts working on the project
- Number of non-Scout youth working on the project
- Number of leaders working on the project
- Number of other adults working on the project
- Total hours worked on the project (number of people times the length of time they worked)
- Cost of materials required to complete the project
- Project category (selected from the dropdown box)
- Type of group benefiting from the project
- The specific group that benefited from the project
